**COLEY, JESSE M., Private**  
 Resided in Cabarrus County and enlisted in Stanly County at age 23, September 7, 1861. Captured at Hanover Court House, Virginia, May 27, 1862. Received at Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, July 12, 1862, for exchange. Declared exchanged at Aiken's Landing on August 5, 1862. Returned to duty prior to January 1, 1863. Wounded in the leg at Chancellorville, Virginia, May 2-3, 1863. Returned to duty on an unspecified date. Wounded and captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland. Transferred to Elmira, New York, July 8, 1864. Released at Elmira on May 29, 1865, after taking the Oath of Allegiance.

**COLEY, JOHN M., Private**  
 Born in Stanly County and resided in Cabarrus County prior to enlisting in Stanly County at age 17, March 2, 1863, for the war. Died on or about June 6, 1864. Place and cause of death not reported.

**COLEY, WILLIAM M., Private**  
 Resided in Cabarrus or Stanly County and enlisted in Stanly County at age 29, September 7, 1861. Captured near Petersburg, Virginia, April 2, 1865. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland. Released on June 24, 1865, *After taking oath of Allegiance / Roll of Honor*

received on September 16, 1863, for exchange. Retired from service on February 11, 1865, by reason of disability from wounds. Paroled at Salisbury on May 16, 1865.

**DAVIS, DAVID D., Private**  
 Previously served in Company D of this regiment. Transferred to this company in February, 1862. Wounded in the left leg and captured at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, July 3, 1863. Left leg amputated. Confined at various Federal hospitals. Paroled at Point Lookout, Maryland, and transferred to City Point, Virginia, where he was received on March 20, 1864, for exchange. Reported absent wounded through February, 1865.

**DAVIS, GEORGE W., Private**  
 Previously served in Company D of this regiment. Transferred to this company in February, 1862. Captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland. Transferred to Elmira, New York, August 15, 1864. Transferred back to Point Lookout on October 11, 1864. Paroled and transferred to Venus Point, Savannah River, Georgia, where he was received on November 15, 1864, for exchange. Returned to duty subsequent to February 28, 1865. Surrendered at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.

**DRAKE, JEFFERSON, Private**  
 Born in Stanly County\* and resided in Cabarrus County where he was by occupation a farmer prior to enlisting in Stanly County at age 47, September 7, 1861. Discharged on March 6, 1862, by reason of "old age and a shortened leg from an old fracture of the thigh bone."

**EARNHARDT, GEORGE R., Private**  
 Resided in Stanly County where he enlisted at age 17, September 7, 1861. Died in hospital at Goldsboro on March 24, 1862, of "typhoid fever."
